- Rider/Handlers must show in a minimum of **3** classes with the **SAME HORSE** to qualify for **DAY END AWARDS.**
- 1 hour of volunteer work REQUIRED at each show day for DAY End Awards
- 4 total hours of volunteer work REQUIRED for YEAR End Awards
- Headers allowed in all driving classes for safety
- Drivers are allowed a secondary driver that is 18yrs or older for safety
- LONG SLEEVE SHIRT, BOOTS AND HAT/HELMET MANDATORY FOR ALL RIDING CLASSES
